# TRANSPORTATION

## FROM THE AIRPORT

SEPTA's Airport Line leaves every 30 minutes—visit [septa.org](http://septa.org) for pricing. To drive into Center City, take a 25-minute taxi ride for a flat rate of \$32 or use a ride-sharing service.

## PARKING

Philadelphia offers plenty of parking options, including paid lots, garages, and metered street parking. When parking on the street, be sure to check signs as some spaces are reserved for residents. Metered parking is easy to pay for with credit cards, cash, or a mobile app. For a parking locator, visit [philapark.org](http://philapark.org).

## BIKE SHARE

Philly's bike share program, Indego, has over 2,000 self-service bikes and 200-plus stations throughout the city, allowing you to rent a bike, go for a ride, and explore Philadelphia, then return your rented bike to any station location. Visit [rideindego.com](http://rideindego.com) for a map of stations.

## PHILLY PHLASH

The Philly PHLASH Downtown Loop is a visitor-friendly public bus that provides convenient and affordable service to stops located near popular tourist destinations and top holiday attractions. With seasonal service, the PHLASH makes it easy for visitors to navigate the city for only \$2 per ride or \$5 per day.

## PUBLIC TRANSIT

### SEPTA

Hop on a SEPTA bus, subway, trolley, or train for easy access to top attractions throughout the city. Visitors can also travel to and from Philadelphia's Countryside via SEPTA Regional Rail out of 30th Street Station, Suburban Station, or Jefferson Station. SEPTA provides updated information on Regional Rail schedules and fares on their website. ### AMTRAK

Enjoy the convenience of traveling to Philadelphia via Amtrak. Skip the traffic and take advantage of downtown-to-downtown service from Philadelphia to all major cities throughout the Northeast Corridor on the Northeast Regional and Acela trains. Amtrak also offers service throughout the state of Pennsylvania on the Keystone and Pennsylvanian routes. You'll arrive in the middle of the action, at the historic 30th Street Station, just a short walk from Center City.

## Getting Around

The **SEPTA** public transportation system ensures inclusivity by providing wheelchair accessibility, equipping all buses with lifts or ramps, accommodating service animals, and offering resources like text readers and Braille on fare kiosks. It also offers many accessible stations for rail, subway, trolley, and bus services, with a complete list available on [septa.org/accessibility](https://septa.org/accessibility).

All buses on the seasonal **Philly PHLASH** loop are wheelchair and stroller accessible.

All **taxi dispatchers** in Philadelphia must accommodate requests for wheelchair-accessible vehicles and collaborate with other dispatchers for service calls. The **2-1-5-Get-A-Cab** mobile app allows users to set a default preference for accessibility, ensuring that every requested ride is in a wheelchair-accessible cab.

Explore Philadelphia with ease by renting scooters, standard wheelchairs, or powered wheelchairs through **Scootaround**. Everything is arranged with visitors beforehand, with equipment ready to go at the hotel upon arrival.

### FOR MORE INFORMATION

Visitors are encouraged to reach out directly to attractions, hotels, or restaurants with requests. These establishments can help assist and accommodate specific needs or requests.

# AMERICA 250

2026 marks the 250th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence—a momentous birthday for the country. July 4th is always big in Philadelphia, and this year the events will be extra festive.

## **JUNE 19 - JULY 4** **WAWA WELCOME AMERICA**

The annual multi-week-long Wawa Welcome America festival will be bigger and better in 2026, with bolder concerts, fireworks, a festive parade, block parties, and more.

## **JULY 2** **RED, WHITE, AND BLUE TO-DO**

Mark the day the Continental Congress voted for Independence with the Red, White, & Blue To-Do Independence Folk Festival plus concerts, parades, games, and evening food and fun.

## **JULY 3** **SALUTE TO AMERICA INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE**

This year, the parade will feature 250 elements, including intricately decorated floats, along with thousands of dancers, marching bands, drum corps, color guards, and drill teams.

## **JULY 4** **CELEBRATION OF FREEDOM CEREMONY**

The patriotic ceremony features special celebrity and VIP speakers, humanitarian award presentations, and a public reading of the Declaration of Independence.

## **BURYING OF THE QUINCENTENNIAL TIME CAPSULE**

Watch the burying of a special time capsule on Independence Mall, which will be opened on July 4, 2276, America's 500th anniversary.

# 250 THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

**52 WEEKS OF FIRSTS** This yearlong festival created by the Philadelphia Historic District honors the city's many historic achievements. "Saturday Firstivals" will take place every week in 2026, highlighting a "first," with free giveaways, Once Upon A Nation storytelling, photo quests, selfie stations, and more! In addition, the city will be filled with 52 #1 sculptures painted by Mural Arts Philadelphia artists, creating a citywide gallery of art.

**BELLS ACROSS PA** This statewide art exhibition, in partnership with America250PA and Mural Arts Philadelphia, will feature painted Liberty Bell replicas—Philadelphia will have 20 of them in and around the city.

**SPIRIT OF 1776 TREES** See the 76 saplings planted around Independence National Historical Park by the Daughters of the American Revolution.

**250 YEARS OF THE AMERICAN FLAG: BETSY ROSS HOUSE** The Betsy Ross House will celebrate 250 years of the American flag with exclusive evening programming that goes behind the scenes with Betsy and the creation of the flag, a week-long Flag Fest celebration in June, opportunities to raise the flag and meet Betsy herself, and a brand new acquisition on display—a piece of furniture from Betsy, donated by one of her descendants.


## MARCH 20 & 22 NCAA MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT





## ALONG THE WATERFRONT

The Delaware River Waterfront is a lively go-to for every age—no matter the temperature.

### FALL/WINTER

Celebrate the winter season at **Independence Blue Cross RiverRink Winterfest** along the Delaware River Waterfront through March 1, 2026. While the ice skating rink serves as the centerpiece, you can also enjoy boardwalk rides and games, cozy up at fire-pit stations, relax in warming cabins, and sip hot cocoa—all under sparkling white lights, with the Benjamin Franklin Bridge as a stunning backdrop.

### SPRING/SUMMER

From June to September 2026, Penn's Landing's winter wonderland

transforms into **Independence Blue Cross RiverRink Summerfest**. Boardwalk games and arcades, mini golf, kids' rides, and a Ferris wheel provide a carnival vibe, while kids and adults whip around the outdoor roller-skating rink.

Nearby, **Spruce Street Harbor Park** continues the festive summer energy, with its riverside hammock lounge, twinkling evening lights, and floating gardens. The park also welcomes live music, DJs, and other special programming, while vendors serve Philadelphia favorites, plus craft beer and cocktails.

## THE GREAT OUTDOORS

Fairmount Park, Philadelphia's expansive urban oasis, stretches across the city, offering trails, parks, woodlands, wetlands, historic homes, and more.

**E**xplore the sprawling 2,050 acres of Fairmount Park year-round. In the spring, meander the winding trails that cut through the urban park to enjoy the blooms and blossoms. Take those same trails in the fall and survey the yellows, reds, and oranges of the autumn leaves. In colder temps, head indoors and tour historic **Woodford, Lemon Hill, and Strawberry Mansion**, open April to December. Of course, in summer, there's no better place to enjoy a picnic.

Situated in the park is **Shofuso Japanese House and Garden**, a replica of a traditional 17th-century Japanese home and a beautifully landscaped garden with a koi fish pond. On March 28-29, the **Subaru Cherry Blossom Festival** celebrates the beauty of Japanese Sakura—the flowering cherry trees that brighten city streets and parks with their distinctive pink and white blossoms.

A modern exhibition hall and greenhouse, **Fairmount Park Horticulture Center** sits on the site of the former Horticultural Hall built for the 1876 Centennial Exposition in West Fairmount Park. Display houses with tropical plants and succulents, demonstration gardens, a reflecting pool, and Cherry Allée in the spring all make for spectacular sights.

Fairmount Park is also home to a rich collection of public art, including works from Frederic Remington, Edward Stauch, and Alexander Milne Calder. Visit the [associationforpublicart.org](http://associationforpublicart.org) for a map of public art throughout the city.

## It's Easy Being Green

Fairmount Park is just one of many green spaces in Philadelphia. The city is called “America’s Garden Capital” because it has more gardens in close proximity than anywhere else on the continent. Here are additional green spaces to visit.

### Wissahickon Valley Park

In the northwest neighborhoods, Wissahickon Valley Park offers miles of picturesque wooded trails along the Wissahickon Creek, with a mix of steep and flat paths that transport you to a woody urban escape. Check out sites like Historic RittenhouseTown, the country’s first paper mill and birthplace of early inventor David Rittenhouse.

### Morris Arboretum & Gardens of the University of Pennsylvania

This Chestnut Hill favorite has indoor


and outdoor gardens, and the 50-foot-high “Out on a Limb,” where children can safely scramble about on rope nettings like squirrels in a tree. The Garden Railroad comes alive in the summer and then again during the holidays.

### Bartram’s Garden

America’s oldest surviving botanical garden was founded by pioneering botanist John Bartram in 1728. The 50-acre garden and National Historic Landmark features the original 18th-century house, rare plant specimens and, coming in 2026, FloatLab—a lime green floating deck installation on the Schuylkill River in partnership with Mural Arts Philadelphia.

### Longwood Gardens

There are plenty of reasons to visit year-round. Seasonal favorites include the Chrysanthemum Festival in the fall, evening light and music fountain shows in the summer, the holiday displays of “A Longwood Christmas,” and of course the blooms of spring.



### **Calder Gardens**

The newest museum along the Benjamin Franklin Parkway is Calder Gardens, an art institution and urban sanctuary dedicated to Alexander Calder, one of the most influential artists of the 20th century.

#### *Henri Rousseau: A Painter's Secrets*

##### **Barnes Foundation**

Through February 22, 2026

See 56 works from this groundbreaking French painter, including *The Sleeping Gypsy* and *The Snake Charmer*, in a whole new light.

#### *Shaun the Sheep: Flock This Way!*

##### **Please Touch Museum**

February 7–May 10, 2026

Visitors can dive into the antics of Shaun and his pals through climbing challenges, stop-motion animation, and imaginative problem-solving. Designed for ages 3–9, this interactive experience transforms Mossy Bottom Farm into a playful destination for families.

#### *Universal Theme Parks: The Exhibition*

##### **The Franklin Institute**

February 14–September 7, 2026

The world-premiere exhibition takes guests inside the

storytelling, innovation, and world-building behind Universal's legendary attractions, from The World-Famous Studio Tour to the new Universal Epic Universe.

#### **Ministry of Awe** • March 14, 2026

Expanding the city's immersive art offerings, muralist Meg Saligman debuts a six-story, interactive work of art in a restored Old City bank that blends visual art, sound, and live performance.

#### *Botany of Nations*

##### **Academy of Natural Sciences**

March 28, 2026–February 14, 2027

In this exhibition, the plants hand-collected by Meriwether Lewis during the Lewis & Clark Corps of Discovery become "portals" into the indigenous ecological knowledge of native nations who have intimately known these remarkable plants for millennia.

April 10, 2026–August 2027

# Philly's Performing Arts

Home to many of the city's top theaters and performing arts groups, the stretch of South Broad Street below City Hall was dubbed the **Avenue of the Arts** in 1993. Grab seats for Broadway shows, jazz, orchestra, dance, and national headliners at **Ensemble Arts Philly**, which includes the **Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts** (home of the **Philadelphia Orchestra**), **Academy of Music**, **Miller Theater**, and **Forrest Theatre**. You'll find stagings of thought-provoking contemporary productions at the **Wilma Theater** and the **Suzanne Roberts Theatre**, home to the **Philadelphia Theatre Company**. See live jazz at the **Philadelphia Clef Club of Jazz & Performing Arts**.

For outdoor performances, check out the **Highmark Mann Center for the Performing Arts** in West Philadelphia. The venue celebrates its 50th birthday in 2026 with an anniversary concert on June 17, 2026, when it premieres *1876: A Hundred Years On*, celebrating the 1876 Centennial Exposition.

## Murals & More

When the weather is just right, head outdoors to see the city's expansive public art collection.

With over 4,500 diverse and colorful works of art on buildings and structures, Philadelphia has earned the nickname "Mural Capital of the World" thanks to **Mural Arts Philadelphia**. Follow one of the self-guided tours along Mural Mile on 13th Street—one north of Market Street, one south of Market, both equally engaging.

Perhaps the most famous artwork in Philadelphia, Robert Indiana's **LOVE sculpture**, is the ideal backdrop for a photo. Situated in LOVE Park, the sculpture rests on a silver platform—yes, you can get in it for a photo. Shot from the City Hall side, you can perfectly frame the Philadelphia Art Museum in the box.

## Convention Center District/ Chinatown

**ANCHORED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA CONVENTION CENTER**, this diverse neighborhood is also home to Philadelphia's bustling **CHINATOWN** and **PENNSYLVANIA ACADEMY OF THE FINE ARTS**—the nation's first art school and museum, founded in 1805.

**DO:** Experience Philadelphia's legendary food culture at **READING TERMINAL MARKET**, where vendors sell everything from Pennsylvania Dutch fare to Middle Eastern specialties to roast pork sandwiches and cheesesteaks—it's one of the oldest and largest public markets in the country. Sign up for a 45-minute behind-the-scenes tour with **CITY FOOD TOURS** to learn about the history and discover hidden gems. Nearby is the **FABRIC WORKSHOP AND MUSEUM**, a free museum that exhibits contemporary textile-based art. Don't miss the fun and funky gift shop. Architecture enthusiasts will marvel at the 1873 **MASONIC TEMPLE**, a National Historic Landmark that blends influences from medieval Europe, Renaissance, neoclassicism, Ancient Egypt, and Asia. Hour-long tours are available Wednesday through Saturday.

**DINE:** Snap a photo in front of Chinatown's iconic Friendship Gate before heading to **CHUBBY CATTLE**, where you can indulge in all-you-can-eat Wagyu Shabu. The restaurant specializes in authentic Chinese hotpot, where fresh meats, seafood, and vegetables are cooked in a bubbling broth at the table. Want a dose of Southern hospitality and live jazz? Dine at **SOUTH RESTAURANT & JAZZ CLUB** for NOLA classics like jambalaya, shrimp & grits, and Creole deviled eggs.

## Old City

**YOUR DESTINATION FOR AMERICA'S 250TH ANNIVERSARY**—it's home to **INDEPENDENCE HALL** and the **LIBERTY BELL** after all—Old City is also a must-visit for its cool galleries, trendy boutiques, and buzzy dining spots. For more on the Semiquincentennial, visit page 7.

**DO:** Family-friendly museums abound in Old City, including the **WEITZMAN NATIONAL MUSEUM OF AMERICAN JEWISH HISTORY**, where powerful exhibits showcase the 360-year history of Jewish people in America. With a diverse array of theater productions, the **ARDEN THEATRE**, an intimate performing arts center, elevates the local theater experience and offers exceptional children's programming—an ideal introduction to live stage performances for young audiences. In the evening, discover Old City's spookier side with a **GHOST TOUR OF PHILADELPHIA**. These candlelit walking tours take you through the back streets and secret gardens of Independence National Historical Park, Old City, and Society Hill, revealing the city's "haunted" past.

**DINE:** James Beard Award-winning restaurateur Ellen Yin celebrates seasonal ingredients and contemporary American fare at her acclaimed restaurant **FORK**. When the weather is nice, enjoy the rooftop deck at **REVOLUTION HOUSE** and dine on elevated comfort food and signature craft cocktails. Traditional Mexican is on the menu at **LAS BUGAMBILIAS**. Think: huevos rancheros, carne molcajete, and chicken in traditional mole sauce, all of which pair perfectly with a margarita.

## Fairmount & Parkway Museums District

**THE FLAG-LINED STRETCH OF BENJAMIN FRANKLIN PARKWAY** is home to some of Philadelphia's finest museums, including the world-renowned **PHILADELPHIA ART MUSEUM**. After touring the museums, stroll into the welcoming Fairmount neighborhood to relax in one of its cozy cafes or bars.

**DO:** Walk along one of Philadelphia's most iconic sites, **BOATHOUSE ROW**, where historic 19th-century boathouses line the eastern bank of the Schuylkill River and still serve as home to active local rowing clubs. At night, they're outlined with thousands of twinkling lights. The boathouses sit along a portion of **SCHUYLKILL RIVER TRAIL**, a scenic multi-use path that extends from Center City Philadelphia through Valley Forge National Historical Park and beyond, perfect for jogging, biking, and leisurely walks. An ideal spot for southern skyline photos is the **SCHUYLKILL BANKS BOARDWALK**, a 2,000-foot-long pathway that stretches from Locust Street to the South Street Bridge.

**DINE:** For fine dining with a dramatic view, take the elevator to the 59th floor of the Comcast Technology Center to **JEAN-GEORGES PHILADELPHIA**. Inside the Four Seasons, it offers exquisitely prepared classic French dishes from famed chef Jean-Georges Vongerichten. Watch a game while dining on bar food favorites at **CITY TAP HOUSE**—the bar features a jumbo TV wall. For endless meat dishes and an authentic Brazilian churrasco dining experience, check out **NABRASA BRAZILIAN STEAKHOUSE**, with 15 flame-grilled cuts of meat served tableside and all-you-can-eat sides.

## Rittenhouse Square

**LOCATED IN THE HEART OF CENTER CITY**, Rittenhouse Square is known for its green spaces, upscale shopping, arts and culture, and alfresco dining.

**DO:** The **MÜTTER MUSEUM** explores the history of medicine and public health through its extensive collection of rare books, archives, historical objects, and biological specimens. Check out the newest exhibit—*Medical Marketing: The Art of Selling a Cure*. Perfect for book lovers, the **ROSENBACH MUSEUM AND LIBRARY**, housed in an 1860s townhouse, preserves the private collection of the Rosenbach brothers, notable rare book dealers. Among the treasures inside: the only surviving copy of Benjamin Franklin's first *Poor Richard's Almanack*, the manuscript of James Joyce's *Ulysses*, and more than 100 personal letters of George Washington. Cap off the evening with a laugh at **HELIUM COMEDY CLUB**, where national and local comics take the stage to perform their sets. The intimate venue offers full food and drink service, making it perfect for a night out.

**DINE:** Stunning interiors and shareable Mediterranean dishes draw crowds to Michael Schulson's **DEAR DAPHNI**. Casual Mexican small plates and inspired tacos delight diners at **ROSY'S TACO BAR**. Don't miss the seasonal margaritas. Theater-goers will enjoy the pre-theater prix fixe menu at **ESTIA**, an authentic Greek restaurant known for its seafood dishes. If you have time, try the popular whole grilled fish. Indulge in prime people-watching and traditional French cafe fare at Stephen Starr's **PARC**, which overlooks Rittenhouse Square.



Many museums (like the Philadelphia Art Museum and Barnes Foundation) have pay-what-you-wish days or discounted evenings—check their websites before you go.

## Gayborhood/Midtown Village/ Washington Square West

**STROLL THROUGH TREE-LINED WASHINGTON SQUARE** and the neighborhood's quaint cobblestone side streets during the day for some of Philadelphia's most photogenic views. At night, enjoy prime dining spots and festive bars.

**DO:** Explore the **GAYBORHOOD**, a historic district denoted by rainbow flags and signs, with restaurants and bars that cater to the LGBTQ+ community. Nearby, **PHILADELPHIA'S MAGIC GARDENS** is an immersive exhibition of mosaic artist Isaiah Zagar's work. The site covers half a city block and includes indoor and outdoor galleries with surfaces covered in mosaics made from handmade tiles, international folk art, ceramic shards, found objects, and more. **PENNSYLVANIA HOSPITAL** is the nation's first chartered hospital, founded in 1751 by Dr. Thomas Bond and Benjamin Franklin. A recently renovated Pine Building will offer guided tours starting in May 2026, with eight exhibition rooms, including the Historic Library and Surgical Amphitheatre. (Online reservations will be required.)

**DINE:** Come for the pub fare menu and rotating drafts; stay for the over-the-top seasonal and holiday decor at **CRAFTSMAN ROW SALOON**. For a cozier vibe, grab a table at **ALPEN ROSE**, a modern steakhouse with steaks, chops, and dry-aged beef. If you want a non-meat alternative, try **MONSTER VEGAN** for comfort classics with a twist and retro movies screening throughout the restaurant.

## Northern Liberties/Fishtown

**JUST NORTH OF CENTER CITY**, these energetic neighborhoods are known for their hip music venues, spirited nightlife, gritty charm and dynamic blend of old industrial architecture and sleek new development.

**DO:** There's plenty to keep you busy in these diverse districts. Enjoy contemporary sculpture and ceramics exhibits at **THE CLAY STUDIO**. You can also try classes and workshops such as general pottery, wheel-throwing, or handbuilding. Stop by **INLIQUID GALLERY** to see work by local and national artists, or join one of its artist talks, tours, or community events. Stroll or bike the **DELAWARE RIVER TRAIL** for waterfront views, parks, and open green space. If you're feeling lucky, head to **RIVERS CASINO** along the riverfront for poker, slots, table games, and live sports betting—then toast your winnings at one of the on-site restaurants or bars.

**DINE:** Mexican favorites, a scratch kitchen, and handcrafted cocktails are a draw to **SOR YNEZ**—as is the large outdoor patio. Enjoy modern interpretations of German classics as well as a stellar selection of German and American beers at **FRANKFORD HALL**, a sprawling indoor-outdoor beer garden with communal tables and a lively atmosphere. Next door, **FETTE SAU** has an enticing selection of barbecue staples like prime beef brisket, pulled pork, and pork ribs plus craft beer and American whiskey.

## South Philadelphia

**THIS HUB FOR PHILADELPHIA SPORTS** is home to the Philadelphia Phillies, Eagles, Sixers, and Flyers. Citizens Bank Park will host the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, and Lincoln Financial Field welcomes FIFA World Cup 26™.

**DO:** Started by Italian immigrants in the late 1880s, the **ITALIAN MARKET** on 9th Street specializes in fresh meat, fruit, cheese, baked goods, and more. Head to **FDR PARK** on Saturday and Sunday to experience the **SOUTHEAST ASIAN MARKET**, with Lao, Khmer, Thai, Indonesian, and Vietnamese vendors. It's open April to October. The park is worth a stop year-round for its paved trails, fishing, tennis/pickleball courts, skate park, and picnic groves. For Revolutionary War history, tour **FORT MIFFLIN**, open March 18 to December 13. The fort earned the nickname "The Fort that Saved America" because it withstood the greatest bombardment of the Revolution, stopping British naval access to Philadelphia and enabling George Washington and his troops to make it to Valley Forge.

**DINE:** Excellent international eateries abound in South Philadelphia. It's walk-ins-only at **ROYAL IZAKAYA**, a celebrated Japanese pub with a chef's sushi counter in the back. **FAMOUS 4TH STREET DELICATESSEN** has been a treasured corner Jewish deli since 1923, legendary for its enormous sandwiches and house-smoked and roasted meats—be sure to save room for the oversized desserts and fresh-baked cookies. The city's only bacon-inspired restaurant, **BAKE'N BACON** serves gourmet comfort food for brunch and dinner in a posh setting.

## University City/West Philadelphia

**HOME TO HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS** like **DREXEL UNIVERSITY** and the **UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA**, the neighborhood features tree-lined streets where Victorian architecture stands alongside cutting-edge research facilities, while Baltimore Avenue serves as a vibrant dining corridor with international cuisine.

**DO:** A 42-acre stomping ground for more than 1,400 animals, the **PHILADELPHIA ZOO** offers a unique way to view big cats, apes, and monkeys through Zoo360, a series of see-through mesh trails that pass through treetops, cross over pathways, and connect habitats. Zoo360 will extend into the recently enhanced new Carey Bear Country so bears can move about the multiple habitats. Explore the renowned **PENN MUSEUM**, one of the world's premier archaeology and anthropology museums, featuring extensive collections from ancient Egypt, Mesopotamia, and cultures worldwide. Opened in November 2025, the new Native North America Gallery explores the political, religious, linguistic, and artistic self-determination of Native peoples across the U.S.

**DINE:** **AFRICATOWN** is a dynamic community and destination for authentic African cuisine, with restaurants like **DORO BET**, lauded for its Ethiopian fried chicken. Sample a wide range of Indian classics at the lunch or dinner buffet at family-owned **NEW DELHI INDIAN RESTAURANT**, the city's oldest-running Indian eatery. The flavors of Northwestern Argentina are on display at **JEZABEL'S**. Try the empanadas, escabeche, and authentic pastries.



Cheesesteaks are a Philly must, but don't sleep on the city's roast pork. Order the sandwich with "rabe and sharp" (broccoli rabe and sharp provolone) for the perfect juicy, garlicky bite.

## Northwest Philadelphia

**DEEPLY ROOTED IN LOCAL HISTORY**, these dynamic neighborhoods are worth a visit for their booming business districts and Revolutionary War-era sites.

**DO:** Explore early America in **HISTORIC GERMANTOWN**, a rich historic district that includes 20 houses, sites, and museums. A must-see is the **JOHNSON HOUSE HISTORIC SITE**, one of the few Underground Railroad stops open to the public. After, visit **THE COLORED GIRLS MUSEUM**, a one-of-a-kind space in Germantown that honors and exhibits artifacts about the Colored Girl experience. To immerse yourself in the Northwest neighborhoods, stroll the inviting business districts of Chestnut Hill, Mount Airy, or Manayunk to enjoy local boutiques, cafes, and neighborhood charm. The Schuylkill River Trail extends through Manayunk along the **MANAYUNK CANAL TOWPATH**. Venice Island is a narrow strip of land formed between the Manayunk Canal and the Schuylkill River, home to an intimate 250-seat theater, outdoor basketball and volleyball courts, and a children's spray park.

**DINE:** Whet your appetite at one of the many neighborhood eateries in the Northwest neighborhoods. **CAKE**, tucked behind Robertson's Flowers in Chestnut Hill, serves breakfast, lunch, and brunch in a bright greenhouse enclosure. Enjoy gastropub fare and Detroit-style pizza at **THE GOAT'S BEARD** in Manayunk, or house craft beer and hearty dishes like brisket or fried chicken sandwiches at the **MOUNT AIRY TAP ROOM**.

## Beyond Philadelphia

**THE REGIONS SURROUNDING THE CITY** offer a wealth of museums, gardens, family-friendly attractions, and retail outlets—perfect for a day trip.

**DO:** Cross the Delaware River to the Camden Waterfront for the family-friendly **ADVENTURE AQUARIUM**, home to thousands of aquatic species. Walk through the Shark Tunnel to get a 180-degree view of sharks as they swim around you; spot hippos swimming around in the immersive Hippo Haven; and enjoy the colorful world of Kaleidoscope Cove, a new exhibit that immerses visitors in a rich underwater world filled with color, technology, and rare marine life. Docked on the waterfront is Iowa-class **BATTLESHIP NEW JERSEY MUSEUM & MEMORIAL**. Having served in World War II, Korean War, Vietnam, Beirut, and the Gulf War, it is the most-decorated battleship in U.S. history.

In Montgomery County, visit **VALLEY FORGE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK**, site of the Revolutionary War encampment. Trails connect key monuments and structures, including log-cabin barracks, Washington's headquarters, and the National Memorial Arch.

Southwest of the city in the Brandywine Valley, world-famous **LONGWOOD GARDENS** is truly a botanical haven. Its recent expansion includes the 32,000-square-foot West Conservatory, with asymmetrical peaks rising from a pool, giving the illusion that the building floats on water. Inside, Mediterranean-inspired gardens with canals and fountains create a tapestry-like design.

## INSIDE TRACK

Walk the Ben Franklin Bridge for a fantastic Philly skyline view. Start at 5th and Race, stroll the pedestrian path, and catch unbeatable sunrise or sunset views over the Delaware River.

Step further back in time at the **Thomas Bond House**, a bed and breakfast in the 1769 home of Dr. Thomas Bond, co-founder of Pennsylvania Hospital. The B&B, part of Independence National Historical Park, has 12 stately rooms and is within walking distance of historical sites.

**If you're all about privacy...** book one of the 14 rooms at the **Fidler Club**, a private club where Philly's elite rub shoulders. Guests have access to the club's sprawling gym and spa, bowling lanes, screening room, golf simulator, and all-day, on-site dining—plus guest rooms with top-of-the-line amenities. Known for its “invisible service,” the **Lokal Hotel** in Old City features six boutique apartment rooms with a mix of vintage and industrial furnishings. Instead of a traditional check-in, guests are given a four-digit code and have total privacy during their stay. Each guest room features a full kitchen, living room, and washer/dryer—a modern home away from home.

**If you crave the art scene...** check in to **The Logan**. With 1,800 pieces of original artwork, the hotel—located at the base of the Benjamin Franklin Parkway's Museum Mile—provides free, guided tours of its collection of paintings, sculptures, and installations, based on availability. ### PHILADELPHIA DISTANCE RUN

September 20, 2026  
Distance: 5K, half-marathon

**Course:** One of the world's fastest half-marathons, it starts and ends on the Parkway and follows Kelly and Martin Luther King Drives.

### ROCKY RUN

November 2026  
Distance: 5K, 10 miles, half-marathon

**Course:** Complete a 5K followed by a 10-mile race for the Italian Stallion medal (along with a 5K and 10-mile medal).

# RACES & REGATTAS

2026 is a huge sports year in Philadelphia—from the PGA Championship to World Cup soccer to the MLB All-Star Game. But the city has been steeped in athletic action for generations—well beyond its stadiums. From roadways to rivers, here are a few more events worth checking out.

## ROOT FOR ROWERS

The heart of Philadelphia's rowing tradition lies along the Schuylkill River. Here, high school, collegiate, and club teams compete in some of the nation's most storied regattas. Boating on the Schuylkill dates back to the city's early days, but the construction of the Fairmount Dam in the 1820s helped lay the groundwork for American rowing. Founded in 1858, the Schuylkill Navy represents the rowing clubs of Boathouse Row and is recognized as the oldest amateur athletic governing body in the United States. The group preserves the sport's rich tradition and hosts many of the river's major races, including these two marquee events:

### Stotesbury Cup Regatta

May 15-16, 2026

The world's oldest and largest high school regatta, the Stotesbury Cup dates back to 1927 and draws competitors from all over North America.

### Head of the Schuylkill Regatta

October 24-25, 2026

One of the largest rowing competitions in the world, this 2.3-mile fall race includes high school, college, master, elite, and adaptive rowers—during peak fall foliage.

# FREE FAMILY FUN

There's no charge for checking out many of Philadelphia's top attractions—from world-famous early American landmarks to engaging science museums. Here are just a few of the deals you'll find in the city.

**1 Visit the Historic Mile.** **Independence National Historical Park**, nicknamed “America’s most historic square mile,” has numerous Revolutionary War and early American sites. Reserve online \$1 timed tickets to **Independence Hall**—where the Declaration of Independence was debated and signed 250 years ago. Stop by **The President’s House**, site of the nation’s first White House from 1790 to 1800, to see the free exhibit *Freedom and Slavery in the Making of a New Nation*. An iconic symbol of freedom, the **Liberty Bell** is on display nearby. Free entrance is first-come, first-serve.

**2 Experience money making at the source** with a free, self-guided tour of the **United States Mint**. Tours include a view of coining operations from 40 feet above the factory floor, a view of the first coining press and other historic artifacts, and seven glass mosaics created by Tiffany of New York. Reservations are not required for this 45-minute tour, Monday to Friday.

**3 Locate the final resting place of famous Philadelphians** at one of the city’s historic cemeteries. Opened in 1836, **Laurel Hill Cemetery**, a National Historic Landmark, is one of the country’s first architecturally designed cemeteries. It has more than 33,000 elaborate mausoleums, graves, and monuments, plus an outdoor sculpture garden and landscaped arboretum. Many of Philadelphia’s elite are buried here, including industry titans, war heroes, artists, and politicians.

**4 Relax in one of the city’s squares.** **Franklin Square**, near Old City and Chinatown, has plenty of green space, a lively playground that’s open year-round, and a carefully restored 1838 fountain that offers free shows mid-April through October. For a small fee, you can also enjoy the colorful Parx Liberty Carousel and Philly-themed mini golf.

**5 Discover a Victorian natural science museum** preserved in near-original form at **Wagner Free Institute of Science**. The National Historic Landmark building houses more than 100,000 natural history specimens including fossils, shells, minerals, and mounted animal skeletons and skins displayed in original wood and glass cabinets. And, as its name states, it’s free.

**6 Delve into the city’s firefighting history** at the free **Fireman’s Hall Museum**. Kids will love the vintage firefighting equipment displayed in the renovated 1898 firehouse. Philadelphia is the birthplace of volunteer fire companies—Ben Franklin founded the city’s Union Fire Company in 1736.

**7 Follow in the steps of Rocky Balboa** with a morning jog up the 72 “Rocky Steps” to the **Philadelphia Art Museum**, then pose for a photo with Rocky’s statue once you’ve cooled down. After, peruse memorabilia at the Rocky Shop just steps away from the statue.


